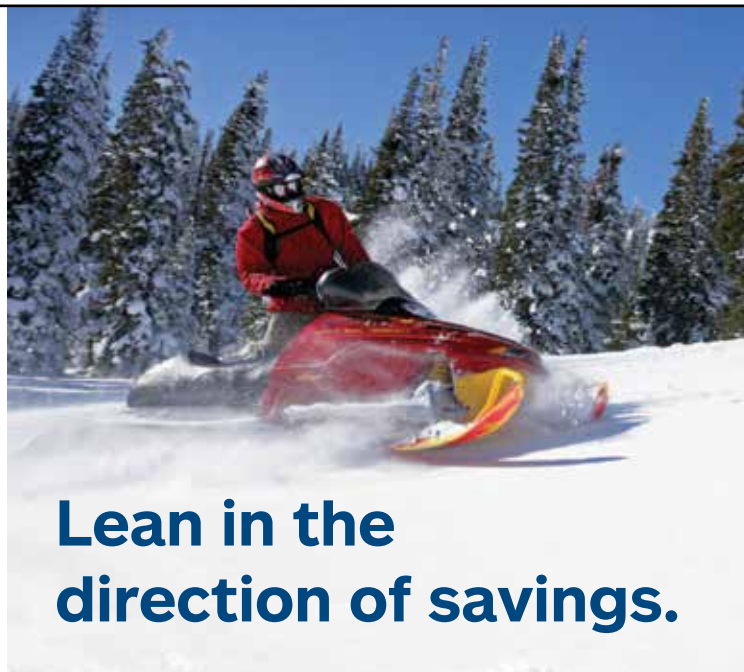

Dear Residents,

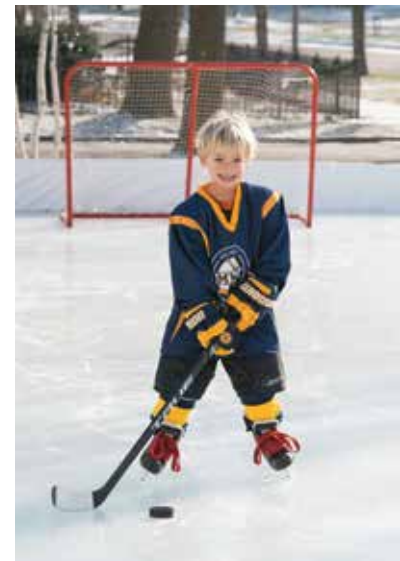

Adult Vaccination By Lori Ahrenhoerster, Public Health Manager

Each year, thousands of adults suffer illness, are hospitalized or even die due to vaccine preventable diseases. Take charge of your health and help protect those around you by asking about vaccines at your next doctor's visit. All adults need immunizations to help them from getting and spreading serious diseases. Some of those vaccines include a seasonal flu vaccine, Tdap to prevent against whooping cough, and a Td (tetanus, diphtheria) booster every 10 years.

The Centers for Disease and Control and Prevention also recommends pneumococcal vaccination for all adults over 65 years of age. Each year in the United States, pneumococcal disease causes thousands of infections, such as meningitis, bloodstream infections and pneumonia. This new recommendation urges all adults over 65 to get vaccinated with both types of pneumococcal vaccines. The two types of pneumococcal vaccines include:

PCV13 (Pneumovax 13): One dose of PCV13 is recommended for all adults 65 years or older who have not previously received the vaccine. A dose of PPSV23 should be given at least one year later. For adults 65 years or older who have already received one or more doses of PPSV23, the dose of PCV13 should be given at least one

year after receiving the most recent dose of PPSV23.

PPSV23 (Pneumovax 23): One dose of PPSV23 is recommended for all adults 65 years or older. People 65 and older should get a dose even if they have gotten one or more doses of the vaccine before they turned 65.

Vaccine recommendations/doses may vary depending on your health condition, age, lifestyle, or occupation. See your primary health care provider to determine which vaccines you need.

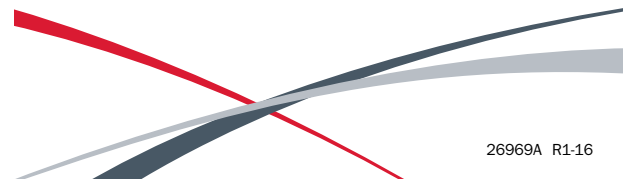

While one might assume that an avid hockey or figure skating family lives in the house with a large ice rink, it really came from the family wanting to enjoy more time with friends and one another at their own house.

Julie and Tim both hail from Toledo, Ohio and although they dated briefly while in high school, the pair went their separate ways for college, and didn't rekindle their relationship until almost 10 years later. Tim received both his bachelors and a PhD in Electrical Engineering, while Julie attended medical school at the Medical College of Ohio, and has been an emergency room physician for over 20 years. Her first position after completing her residency was for the group Emergency Medicine Specialists, which moved her from Toledo to Milwaukee. "When I was house hunting, my main requirement was to be in a walkable community. In 1997, I bought my first house in Whitefish Bay because it was just so adorable. A year later Tim moved up here and proposed in the sunroom of our house! After growing to love our neighbors and the community, we couldn't imagine leaving our house, so instead after having our two children, we added an addition onto the former two-bedroom house," said Julie.

The couple have two high school children, Clyde (16) and Jane (14) who are both named after a grandparent. Clyde is a junior at MUHS and enjoys hockey, cross-country skiing, and playing guitar. Jane is a freshman at DSHA and enjoys skating, cross-country skiing and paddleboarding. When the kids were younger, a family friend had an ice rink in his backyard, and Tim loved the idea of something active for



the family to do in the winter months. This inspired Tim to create one in their front yard. "The first year the rink was mainly for Tim to see if it could be done. Then our children started using it and loved having it, especially when friends would come over, it is always a huge hit! Now every winter both our kids and the neighborhood kids can't wait for the rink to be filled up and frozen to skate in," said Julie.

A unique side story to the Doniere family is how they were able to manage both Julie and Tim having full-time careers and never needing daycare or a nanny when their children were young. With Julie being an emergency room doctor, she was able to have her schedule set to working only night-shifts, while Tim worked during the days at Mortara Instruments as a software engineer. Usual around dusk as the kids are coming back from sports or school, the neighbors magically show up with lawn chairs and a bottle of wine. These are some of my favorite evenings, and I hope life-long memories for my kids. In the winter when the kids come to skate,

As much as the kids love when the rink goes up for the winter, most of the adults smile when the rink comes down,

only because they know it means warmer weather is on the way. Their rescue dog, Marcie, has also become an fan of the rink, normally hoping up to slide around on the ice while the kids skate. The family has an open skate policy on their rink, so if you happen to drive by their house when the ice is still frozen,

take your skates out for a lap or two around their impressive ice rink. ●

Electrical Safety In and Around Your Home

Flipping a light switch, plugging in a coffee maker, charging a laptop computer; these are all probably second nature for most of us. Electricity makes our lives easier in many cases; however, we need to be cautious and keep safety in mind.

Some simple tips can help to keep you as safe as possible at home:

- Have all electrical work done by a qualified electrician
- When you are buying or remodeling a home, have it inspected by a qualified inspector.
- Only use one heat-producing appliance (such as a coffee maker, toaster, space heater etc.) plugged into a receptacle outlet at a time.
- Major appliances (refrigerators, dryers, washers, stoves, air conditioners, etc.) should be plugged directly into a wall receptacle outlet. Extension cords and plug strips should not be used.
- Arc fault circuit interrupters (AFCIs) shut off electricity when a dangerous condition occurs. Consider having them installed in your home by a qualified electrician.
- Use ground fault circuit interrupters (GFCIs) to reduce the risk of shock. GFCIs shut off an electrical circuit when it becomes a shock hazard. They should be installed in the home in bathrooms, kitchens, garages and basements. All outdoor receptacles should also be GFCI protected.
- Check electrical cords to make sure they are not running across doorways or under carpets. Extension cords are intended for temporary use only and should not be used long term. Have a qualified electrician add more receptacle outlets so you don't have to use extension cords.
- Use light bulbs that match the recommended wattage on the lamp or fixture. There should be a sticker that indicates the maximum wattage light bulb to use.

Always call a qualified electrician or your landlord if:

- You have frequent problems with blowing fuses or tripping circuit breakers.
- A tingling feeling when you touch an electrical appliance
- Discolored or warm wall outlets
- A burning or rubbery smell coming from an appliance
- Flickering or dimming lights
- Sparks from an outlet

Don't ever hesitate to call 9-1-1 if you're ever in doubt. Electricity can be great when it's working properly, but it can also have devastating consequences when things aren't just right. Perhaps you missed the deadline to license your dog or cat on December 31? We get it. The holidays were happening. Then the Packers were on a playoff roll. Things can slip your mind, but, the deadline to renew your license before a late fee kicks in is March 31, 2017.

Fortunately, MADACC has a great opportunity for you to get super-low cost vaccines, both rabies and combo vaccines, microchips, and your license all in one stop!

Mark your calendars for MADACC's Low Cost Vaccine Clinic, taking place at the MADACC at their facility (located at 3839 W. Burnham Street, West Milwaukee) on Saturday, March 25th at 10am – 2pm.

To make things run smoothly, we require pre-registration and payment. The line can be long, so by having all the paperwork and payments collected ahead of time leads to quick and orderly appointments to get as many animals done as possible. Fees are as follows:

- Canine/Feline Rabies.....\$5
- Canine/Feline Combo vaccine\$5
- Microchip.....\$20
- License.....\$12 for sterilized animals/\$24 for intact animals

This is a once a year event, a big value, and a great way to save money and comply with state law! To register, visit the MADACC facility in person, or go to our website at www.madacc.org and download a mail-in registration form. People that show up the day of the event that have not pre-registered will pay the regular fees, so it is important to register today! 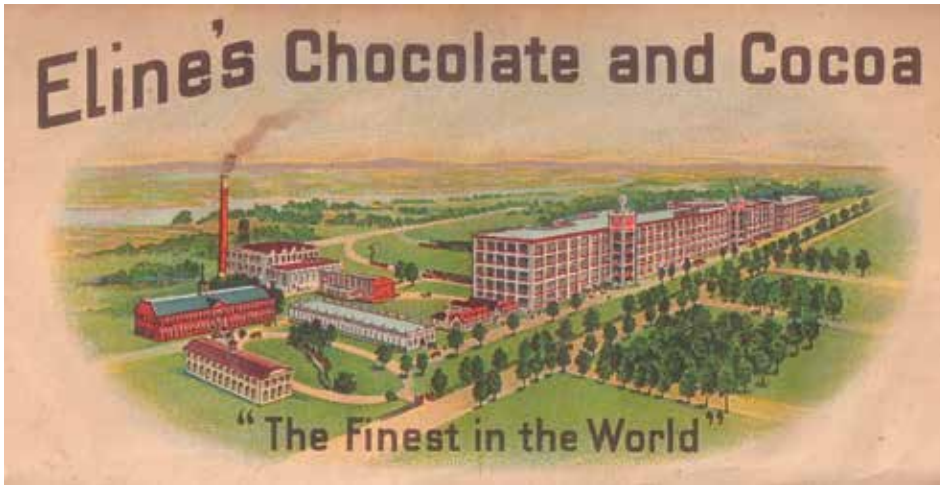

The Sweet Smell of Disaster

During Prohibition, the Jos. Schlitz Brewing Co. needed a product to replace beer. Whitefish Bay's Herman Uihlein sat on the Schlitz board of directors. In his blog MilwaukeeNotebook.com, History Writer Carl Swanson relates the business idea the Uihleins executed on Whitefish Bay's border.

From its massive factory to the staggering amount of money lost, everything about Eline's Chocolate and Cocoa Co. was outsized. The venture was launched by the Uihleins, owners of the Jos. Schlitz Brewing Co. It's not easy to go from Beer Baron to Count

Chocolate but they tried. The family built a sprawling factory at Port Washington and Hampton Roads, hired an army of workers, and launched an ambitious marketing campaign.

In 1920 transitioning from beer to bonbons made sense. Prohibition made it illegal to manufacture, sell, or transport alcoholic beverages in the US. Schlitz needed a replacement business. Milwaukee was then a center of candy production so with unlimited capital at their disposal, the Uihleins entered the candy market on a huge scale. They theorized that with beer and liquor cut

off, people would turn to chocolate.

What a factory they built! Willy Wonka had nothing on the Uihleins. Newspapers wrote of lobbies paved with imported Italian marble, of fireplaces in every office, and of a garage modeled after the orangery at Apthorpe Hall in England. The entrance pillars were inspired by those at Harvard University.

Until then, the Uihleins had tasted nothing but success. That would change,

In 1928 the company was liquidated. Newspapers focused on the company's missteps. Eline's Almond Bars might or might not contain almonds, gum balls sometimes shattered when dropped, and the company briefly used a food-grade lubricant made from fish oil on its packaging machinery which made the chocolates taste fishy.

But the real problem was the ocean of red ink into which the company was sinking. The family invested a fortune to muscle its way into a highly competitive business and failed to capture a significant share of the market. The factory lasted less than 10 years and burned through \$17 million.

The four-story factory survived the collapse of the candy company and housed an armaments plant in World War II. It was later demolished. The office building on Port Washington Road still stands, as does the gate house.

Prohibition ended in 1933 and happily the Uihleins returned to brewing.

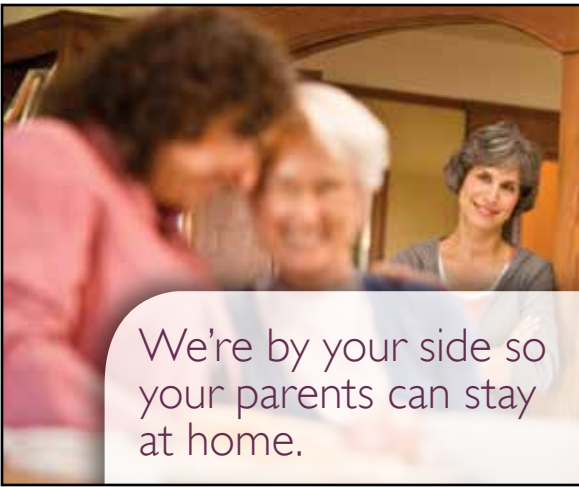

Irresistible Make-Ahead Egg Bake

There is never a bad time for egg bake; breakfast, lunch and dinner are all perfect times to enjoy this filling entree. It is nice to have a recipe that I can walk away from after I put it together, especially during the holidays when time is tight and I am spending hours on end in the kitchen. There is no babysitting this irresistible dish!

Ingredients

- 1 package of crescent roll dough
- 1 package of hash browns
- 1 pound of ground breakfast sausage or sausage links/patties chopped into ½ inch pieces
- 2 tablespoons maple syrup
- 8 eggs
- ¼ milk
- 1½ cup cheese

Directions

Heat oven to 375 degrees. In a greased 11x9 pan, unroll the crescent roll dough and lay it flat in the bottom of the pan. Pour hash browns over the dough and spread sausage pieces evenly throughout. Drizzle maple syrup over the layers in the pan; scramble the eggs with milk and pour over. Top evenly with cheese and bake for 40 minutes.

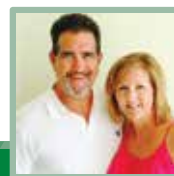
