***Acceptable forms of Voter ID**—*Your ID does not need to show your current address.*

- ★ Wisconsin driver license or state ID card expiring after November 3, 2020
- ★ U.S. passport expiring after November 3, 2020
- ★ Military ID card expiring after November 3, 2020
- ★ Tribal ID, regardless of expiration
- ★ Certificate of naturalization issued within last two years
- ★ Unexpired Wisconsin driver license or state ID receipt
- ★ ID card issued by a federally recognized Indian tribe in Wisconsin
- ★ ID card issued by a WI accredited university or college—must contain issuance date, student signature, and expiration within two years of issuance; if expired, also include proof of current enrollment.
